- Competition Rules:** Competition according to WTF Rules. A single elimination tournament system shall apply.
- Sport Equipment:**
- Participating contestants are required to wear WTF-recognized doboks and WTF-recognized protective equipment.
 - KP&P Protector Scoring System (PSS) will be used and provided by the OC.
 - KP&P Electronic Headgear will be used and will be provided by the OC.
 - Sensing Socks, groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves may be brought by the contestants. The equipment will also be sold at the venue. Mouth piece is compulsory!
- Award Presentation :** Medals for the places from 1 to 3 - Individual results.

For Senior Player Category

Qualifications:

- Holder of the National Poom/Dan Certificate and Kukkiwon Poom/Dan Certificate
- An athlete must be 17 years old or older. An athlete who was born in the year of 2000 or before is eligible to participation in the Championships.
- Holder of the WTF Global Athlete License (GAL)

Weight Categories:

Senior Male: -54 kg, -58 kg, -63 kg, -68 kg, -74 kg, -80 kg, -87 kg, +87 kg

Senior Female: -46 kg, -49 kg, -53 kg, -57 kg, -62 kg, -67 kg, -73 kg, +73 kg

Entry Fee: US\$ 50 per athlete;

Registration period starts 9th March 2017 and ends **9th April 2017.**

Changes of weight divisions after the deadline are allowed for additional US\$ 25.

For Junior Player Category

Qualifications:

- Holder of the National 2nd Gup and above Certificate and Kukkiwon 2nd Gup and above Certificate
- An athlete must be 15 -17 years old. An athlete who was born in the year of 2000 - 2002 is eligible to participation in the Championships.
- Holder of the WTF Global Athlete License (GAL)

Weight Categories:

Junior Male : -45 kg, -48 kg, -51 kg, -55 kg, -59 kg, -63 kg, -68 kg, -73 kg, -78 kg, +78 kg

Junior Female: -42 kg, -44kg, -46 kg, -49 kg, -52 kg, -55 kg, -59 kg, -63kg, -68 kg, +68kg

Entry Fee: US\$ 50 per athlete;

Registration period starts 9th March 2017 and ends **9th April 2017.**

Changes of weight divisions after the deadline are allowed for additional US\$ 25.

Conditions of Participation:

1. All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a WTF Global Athlete Licence (GAL) or Global Official Licence (GOL)
2. *Entry Registration:* Entry will only be accepted through the new WTF online registration system -
3. *Entry Fee:* All payments for each contestant should be paid online after registration or in cash to OC at the Accreditation Center in Atyrau, Kazakhstan, prior to the start of tournament. Athletes will not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee.

Notice: There will be "NO" WTF Global Licence registration onsite. Please be sure you have valid GAL/GOL before you register.

Accommodation and transportation:

1. Round trip airfare shall be covered by each participating team.
2. All the reservations must be made by filling accommodation forms and sending it to the OC. The rates and room options will be sent as **Accommodation Guide** attachment.
3. Ground transportation will be provided for participants on arrival and departure, only from airport to official hotels and vice versa, as long as the OC will be informed of the date, time, number of team members and flight schedule at the latest by **April 9th, 2017**.
4. All participating teams must submit their hotel and transport reservations to secure their accommodation and ground transportation by no later than **April 9th, 2017**.

Insurance: All competitors of 2017 Kazakhstan Open Taekwondo Championships are considered to participate at their own risk. The Kazakhstan Taekwondo Federation and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses directly or indirectly result from 2017 Kazakhstan Open Taekwondo Championships.
All contestants must bring their own documents and medical insurance forms for any medical treatment they may need whilst in Kazakhstan.

Anti-Doping Test: Use of drugs or doping by any chemical substances prescribed in the WTF Regulations for Doping Control is strongly prohibited. International Referees:

1. International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
2. The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses for seven (5) nights stay of room and board. **Check-in: April 20 (Thursday) / Check-out: April 25 (Tuesday)**
3. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$100 to the mentioned International Referees for each competition day.
