Qualifications:

In accordance with Article 4:

Qualification of Contestant of the WTF

Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

CRITERION No.1: Holder of the nationality of the participating team

CRITERION No.2: One recommended by the National Taekwondo Association

CRITERION No.3: Holder of the Kukkiwon Dan Certificate aged 15 and above,

based on the year of 2010. i.e. contestants born on and after

January 1, 1995.*

A copy of the Dan certificate must be enclosed for registration of accreditation. Contestants without accreditation will not be allowed to participate. In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be enclosed when registering for accreditation. 












The current WTF/PATU Competition Rules shall govern this 17th Pan American Taekwondo Championships.

Every national taekwondo association is permitted to enter no more than one contestant per weight division per classification. Therefore, the maximum number of entries per National Taekwondo association is:

ii.Team Awards

Based on the point system below, the following team awards will be presented to the winning teams at the closing ceremony.

Based on the best competition results in individual competition, the following awards will be presented to individuals.

- "Best Male Athlete"
- "Best Female Athlete"
- "Best Male Coach"
- "Best Female Coach"
- "Best Male Referee"
- "Best Female Referee"

Conditions for participation:

i.Airfare and Accommodation

Round trip airfares and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating national federations.

ii.Entry Fees

Male Team: \$300,00 USD

Female Team: \$300,00 USD











i.PATU will appoint the required number of International Referees and Competition Supervisory Board (CSB) members.

ii.There will be six (6) CSB members to be appointed by PATU. The total number of the CSB members will be seven (7) including the chairman who is also the WTF International Delegate as specified in the WTF competition rules and regulations.

iii.Roundtrip Airfare shall be borne by each participating International Referee and CSB Member.

iv.The Organizing Committee shall cover (4) nights charges of room and board. (check in in the afternoon of December 7th, 2010; checkout before 10 AM of December 11th, 2010).

v.The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of USD\$100 per day for three days to the selected International Referees and CSB members who will officiate in the three days of 17th Pan American Taekwondo Championships.









Wtf technical delagate and patu technical officials:

WTF will appoint an International Technical Delegate in accordance with WTF rules and regulations. WTF International Delegate will serve as the chairman of the CSB. The PATU will appoint required number of PATU Technical Officials to manage all matters related to the 17th Pan Am Taekwondo Championships. The following conditions shall apply:

i.The OC shall provide air fares, room and board for WTF International Technical Delegate and PATU Officials up to 5 nights of stay, (check in in the afternoon of December 6th, 2010; checkout before 10 AM of December 11th, 2010)

vi. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of USD\$500.00 to the WTF Technical Delegate and PATU Officials for their services in the 17th Pan American Taekwondo Championships.

















WTF-recognized taekwondo uniform (dobok) and protective equipment:

i.Participating contestants are required to wear WTF/PATU-recognized doboks and WTF/PATU-recognized protective equipment.

ii.The Organizing Committee will provide head and electronic body protectors to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring along their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

iii.Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their doboks and protective equipment. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.









THE REAL PROPERTY.

Pan American Taekwondo Championship

Official scoring system:

LaJUST Electronic Body Protector (EBP) and its Scoring System will be used for this 17th Pan Am Taekwondo Championships to promote the spirit of "Fair Play" in competition, In addition to the LaJUST EBP Scoring System, "Instant Video Replay System" will be utilized in accordance with WTF competition rules to ensure fair and impartial judging for all participants. All appointed officials and referees will have detailed training sessions prior to the competition to assure best match results in competition.



Anti-doping medical control:

PATU, with assistance of the Mexico Organizing Committee, will carry out Anti- Doping Tests required by the WTF by following WADA program.













Weigh-in:

i.Weigh-in for contestants of all weight divisions and classifications shall be completed one (1) day before the championships. Therefore, the weigh-in for the 17th Pan American Taekwondo Championships will be held on December 8, 2010.

ii.During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. Contestants may also choose to conduct the weigh-in without any clothing on.



Head of team meeting & drawing of lots session:

i.The head of team meeting and the drawing of lots session shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the championships, in the presence of the WTF Technical Delegates, PATU officials and the representatives of the participating nations. The drawing of lots shall be done electronically in an ascending order of the weight divisions (i.e. from the lightest to the heaviest weight divisions).











ii.The order of the draw may be changed depending on the decision of the Technical Delegate, upon consultation with the participating officials at the Head of Team meeting.

iii.PATU will conduct automatic electronic drawing of lots and duly notify the officials of the participating nations who are not present at the time of the lot drawing session.

iv. The official drawing of lots will be done electronically. In case advanced seeding is allowed, the official drawing of lots may be done manually.

Indemnities:

i.The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that their participants have validly completed and signed the official participation forms, thus indemnifying the WTF, PATU, organizers, appointed officials and other contestants from any claims of injuries, losses, fatalities or otherwise arising in the course of participation in this championships or any activities thereto.











ii. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.

iii.Participants without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.

iv. The Organizing Committee will acquire general insurance, at its own expenses, for the contestants and staffs, in the event of any injury that may arise during the course of the championships.



National flag and anthem:

Every participating national taekwondo association is required to bring along the following items for use at the Opening and/or Closing ceremonies:

i.Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags Size: 90cm x 130cm ii.Cassette tape or CD of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem

















Closing date for entries:

The entry form is enclosed herewith and should be submitted to the Organizing Committee and a copy to the PATU Tournament Committee (eey314@yahoo.com) by no later than November 15, 2010. PATU Tournament Committee Chairman will verify eligibility of the athletes upon receipt of entry.



Local transportation:

Local transportation from and to the airport, designated official hotels and competition venue will be provided by the Organizing Committee. All participating national teams are requested to fill out the attached forms and send them back to the Organizing Committee by no later than November 15, 2010.

















VISA:

Any participating National Federation requires an assistance from Mexican TKD Federation to attain Mexican Sports Entry Visas, the pertinent member national federation president must submit a letter of request with the official list of national team members to the Organizing Committee at least three months prior to the event for the OC to send out a letter of assistance to Mexican authorities.
