ELIGIBILITY: All participants must satisfy the following requirements in order to participate.

Holder of the Nationality of the participating team.

Recommended by the National Taekwondo Association.

Holder of the WTF Global Athlete Licnse (GAL).
Holder of the Kukkiwon Poom or Dan Certificate.

*A Copy of the Kukkiwon Dan certificate shall be enclosed with registration for accreditation. If this requirement is not fulfilled the contestant will not be able to participate.

**In the case of late obtainment of the Dan/Poom certificate from the Kukkiwon which is in progress, a copy of the Dan/Poom application form & remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon shall be enclosed when registration for accreditation. Please refer to the Kukkiwon website (www.kukkiwon.or.kr) for more information.

Contestant for Poomsae & Kyorugi competition will be between the ages of 12—17 years old, based on the year of 2015. Contestant will have been born between January 1998 and December 31, 2003. Passport will be used as proof of age and nationality.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS: The competition regulations will be based on those established by WTF.

Scoring System for Selection of Team Winners:

Team winners shall be determined by the point totals based on the following guidelines:

1 point per competing participant that has entered the area of competition, after having passed the official weigh in.

1 point for each winning contestant (Including Byes).

7 points per gold medal, 3 points per silver medal. 1 point per bronze medal.

Terms and Conditions of Participation:

Round trip airfares and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating national federations.

Entry fee of \$300 USD for each male and female team with up to 3 competitors shall be enclosed in the application forms.

Entry fee of \$500 USD for each male and female team with 4 or more competitors shall be enclosed in the application forms.

All Participation Fees shall be paid by CASH in US DOLLAR by the Accreditation Desk.

International Referees:

PATU will appoint the required number of International Referees.

Roundtrip Airfare shall be borne by each participating International Referee.

The Organizing Committee shall cover (7) nights charges of room and board (check-in in the afternoon of September 07, 2015; checkout before 11:00 AM of September 14, 2015).

The Organizing Committee will provide each participating International Referee with a daily honorarium of US \$100 for each day of competition, plus (1) day of training.

WTF - Recognized Taekwondo Uniform (Dobok) and Protective Equipment:

Participating athletes will wear a WTF – recognized Taekwondo uniform (dobok) and the WTF – recognized protective equipment, including shin and forearm guards, gloves as well as the groin guards.

The Organizing Committee will provide WTF – recognized electronic head protectors and trunk protectors (EBP) for the participating athletes, but participating athletes are required to bring the groin guards, gloves, mouth guards, shin and forearm guards, and Daedo electronic sensor socks for their personal use.





All participating athletes will be required to proceed to the inspection area for officials to check their dobok and protective equipment prior to entering the competition floor. Any contestant wearing unofficial dobok or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete. Any unauthorized modification or alteration to the electronic sensor socks or any protective equipment shall result an immediate disqualification.

Weigh-In:

Weigh-in of the athletes shall be completed one day before their competition day.

At weigh-in male contestants can wear underpants and female athletes can wear underpants and brassieres. Athletes may also weigh in the nude if they chose to do so.

Indemnities:

It shall be the responsibility of the respective national federations to ensure that their participants have validly completed and signed the official participation forms, thus releasing the PATU, organizers, its officials and other contestants from any claims of injuries, losses, and fatalities or otherwise arising from the participation in this championship or any activities thereto.

It shall be the responsibility of the respective national associations to ensure that all officials, athletes and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.

Participant's without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.

Head of team Meeting and Drawing of Lots:

The head of team meeting and the drawing of lots shall be conducted one day prior to the first competition in the presence of the PATU officials and the representatives of the participating nations. The drawing of lots shall be done Electronically by utilizing automatic draw system.

National Flag and Anthem:

It is the responsibility of each participating national team to bring the following items for use at the opening and closing ceremonies as well as at the awards presentation ceremonies:

Two (2) national flags. Size: 90cm x 130 cm

Only IOC recognized national flags will be permitted.

A CD of the respective nation's national anthem.

Accommodation:

Each participating teams are responsible for their hotel accommodations and meals.

Hotel information and reservation forms are included in this information packet.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any matters that occur during the championships if participation nations, officials and athletes do not stay at the official host hotels.

Ground transportation:

Ground transportation will be provided for national teams upon arrival and departure, provided the national team arrives into the Aguascalientes, Mexico and the Organizing Committee has been informed of the date, time, and flight schedule of the national team at the latest by August 25, 2015.

The Organizing Committee will also provide ground transportation to and from all host hotels and the venue, in a period between September 6~9, 2015.

Entry Forms and Closing Dates for Entries:

All entry forms must reach the Organizing Committee by August 31, 2015. Entries received after the deadline will be subject to late charges and fees. Strict compliance with this ruling is requested. Entries Received by: August 31, 2015: No Late Charges and Fees.

September 1~3, 2015: \$600.00 per Male or Female Team regardless of participating athlete number. Absolutely no registration will be accepted on or after September 4, 2015.

All Coaches who have completed InterContinental Coach Seminar, coach fees are waived. Otherwise, coach fee shall be \$300.00

Competition Rules: WTF/PATU Poomsae Competition Rules

Method of competitions: Cut-off system

Preliminaries: After performing two (2) of the four (4) 1st Compulsory Poomsae predetermined by the PATU, the top 50% of participants will qualify for the next round according to the average score of the two performances.

Final selection: The top 50% of participants would be required to perform the remaining two (2) 1st Compulsory Poomsae. The top eight (8) athletes of each category (individual, team and pair) will be selected according to the average score of the two performances.

Final: The top eight (8) athletes of each category would be required to perform two (2) of the 2nd Compulsory Poomsae predetermined by the PATU. The ranking of the top three (3) athletes of each category will be decided by the average score of the two performances.

2nd Pan American Cadet Poomsae & 4th Pan American Junior Poomsae Championships

Competition Format

Individual, Pairs and Team Competition:

- * 1st Compulsory Poomsae: Taeguek 4,5,6,7
- * 2nd Compulsory Poomsae: Taegeuk 8 Jang, Koryo, Keumgang, Taeback
- * Final Compulsory Poomsae: Only the 1st and 2nd place winners from 1st, 2nd, & 3rd dan divisions will have a final round to select Pan Am Junior Poomsae Champions. PATU Techincal Committee and participating coaches for the finalists will vote on one form from Koryo, Keumgang or Taebaek.

Free Style Poomsae: Each team is allowed a maximum of 7 competitors per team. All Free Style Created Poomsae Team Competition must be performed with music of each team's choice. Free Style Created Poomsae Team Competition must be completed within 3 minute time frame. The length of each participating team's free style created poomsae must be a minimum of 1 minutes and maximum of 3 minutes including the set up time. Judging will be done based on the current WTF Free Style Poomsae Competition Rules.

Awards:

1st Place: Gold Medal (1) and Award Certificate
2nd Place Silver Medal (1) and Award Certificate

3rd Place Bronze Medal (1) and Award Certificate for each medalist

Terms and Conditions of Participation:

Round trip airfares and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating national federations. The registration is open to all Junior and Cadet competitors of Pan American Region without going through national Poomsae Team Selections to eliminate financial burdens to each national federations. However, each competitors must be a citizen and a registered member of pertinent member national federations. All participants must submit written permissions from their national federation. Since no national federation is holding Junior and Cadet Poomsae Team selections, no federations will be financially responsible for these individuals or teams. All participants will be responsible for their own airfare, entry fees, room and board for the Pan American Junior and Cadet Poomsae Competition. In exchange, PATU will recognize all winners as the official winners of the 4th Pan American Junior Poomsae or 2nd Pan American Cadet Poomsae Championships.

The maximum competitor number will be reached based on first come first serve bases.

All other matters will be governed by the current WTF/PATU Poomsae Competition Rules and Regulation.


