All athletes will be seeded 100% according to the WT World ranking applicable to the dates of the

competitions

COMPETITION RULES

Competition Rules as of September 1, 2022, shall be applied (www.worldtaekwondo.org/rules/)

CONTEST TIMES

Senior and Junior: 3 round of 2 minutes with 1 minute break

Cadet: 3 round of 1,5 minutes with 1 minute break

(The contest times can be modified by WT TD and will be announced during the technical meeting of the event)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS - ATHLETES

1. Holder of the nationality of the participating team.
2. The pre-registration information shall be extended to the pertinent member national taekwondo association that is recognized by the World Taekwondo.
3. Holder of valid WT Global Athlete Licence (GAL).
4. An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in:
 - Seniors: 2005 or before
 - Juniors: 2005, 2006 or 2007
 - Cadets: 2008, 2009 or 2010

All competitors shall certify their age, with their national id or passport during the weigh-in

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS - COACH:

1. Must be 21 years old or above.
2. Holder of a valid WT Global Official License 2022 (GOL).
3. Holder of WT Coach Certification Course Lvl 1.

COACH's ATTIRE All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trouser during Semi-Finals and Finals. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to coach

WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- i. PSS DAEDO GEN 2 and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear will be used for the competition.

- CADETS: PSS GEN 2
- JUNIOR : PSS GEN 2
- SENIOR : PSS GEN 2

II. Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized Kyorugi competition uniform and WT recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT

(<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html>).

iii. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthguard, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

UNIFORM /DOBOK

The contestants shall use the white uniform with black "v" neck in proper conditions and from the WT recognized brands. Names, logos, team name, NOC code are allowed following WT rules regarding competition Uniforms/dobok.

PROTECTION GEAR

Athletes shall enter the FOP with their protection gear approved by WT. The protection gear except head gear and chest gear shall be use under the dobok.

It's not allowed to use any other object/protection a part form the head gear (with the exception of the Hijab). Other religious articles are allowed if they are use under the dobok and don't represent a hazard for the owner or others

MEDALS AND POINT AWARDED

Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight category of the pertinent competition

GOLD: 7 POINTS.

SILVER: 3 POINTS.

BRONCE: 1 POINT.

REFEREES:

1. PATU will designate the number of the IR's
2. Air tickets must be paid by each international referee
3. The Organizing Committee will cover lodging and food, four nights for each referee, in addition to internal ground transportation.
4. The Organizing Committee will provide each international referee with an honorarium of USD 100 for each of the three days of competition and one day of training.

WEIGH-IN

1. General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category.
2. Random weigh-in of the contestants shall take place in the morning on the competition day of their respective weight category except M+80 & W+67. All contestants in draw must be presented
3. During the weigh-in, the male competitor must wear underpants and the female competitor must wear underpants and a brassieres.
4. The cadet and junior competitor must be weighed with underwear and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate

MEDICAL CONTROL

1. The Organizing Committee will only provide medical services in emergency situations when an athlete in competition suffers an injury.
2. Participants are responsible for expenses for injury and/or hospitalization
3. The Organizing Committee recommends that participants have medical insurance and have the documents at hand.

REGISTRATION FEE.

Registration fees are non-refundable under any circumstances or conditions.

Each participant is responsible for the costs generated by air and ground transportation, accommodation and food.

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The Registration Fee shall be pay on cash at the registration Center, the registration period and fee will be determined by the date and time registered in the GMS system.

DEADLINE. (GMT -4)

The multiple registration – two or more are only applicable for Poomsae Contestants, Kyorugi contestants shall only have one registration in one weight division. The two registrations on Kyorugi event could only be accepted in the case that the contestant it is also a coach. In the case of Poomsae Event, the same athlete can only participate in 2 subevents, for example one individual and one in teams or pair, or two individuals one in recognized and one in freestyle.

VISAS:

Due to this process is important that the information available in the GMS platform in terms of name, DOB and passport information is accurate and up to date, to avoid problems with the accuracy of the visa letters.

4. Best female and male athlete G -2 Poomsae and Korugi trophy will be awarded.
5. Trophies will be awarded for the best female and male coach G -2 Poomsae and Korugi.
6. Trophy for team 1st place, 2nd place and 3rd of the G-2 Poomsae And Korugi.

POOMSAE

Each team can register as many athletes as they wish in each one of the categories, but **the same athlete shall only be register in a maximum of two (2) categories/subevents**; for example: one in an individual category and one in team or pair, or two individuals' categories, one in recognized and one in freestyle.

They may be other social and economic risks and losses not known to me or not foreseeable by me at this time; I accept, acknowledge and fully assume the responsibility, cost and damages that may be incurred as a result of my participation or that of the minor in the activity. I declare by this document, and hereby agree that I will not sue before any court (criminal, civil), of the State of Chile against the Organizers of this Chilean Taekwondo Open convened for September 23, 24 and 25 of the year 2022 to the CHILEAN FEDERATION OF TAEKWONDO WT, including its representatives, officials, directors, organizational committee, in general, technicians and coaches and the families of each one of them, to all the sponsors, each one of them is relieved of responsibility, of lawsuits, losses, or damages in my account caused or alleged to be prosecuted in whole or in part, with the exception of those indicated in the Chilean Law of Violence in Stadiums. I have read this agreement, I fully understand its terms, therefore I have proceeded to sign this document freely and voluntarily.

As the minor's parent and/or custodial relative, I understand that the nature of athletic activities and the minor's experience and abilities, that the minor is in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity.
