6. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY:

In accordance with article 4 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

- 1. Holder of Nationality of the participating team
 - 1.1 Athletes with a refugee status issued by either governmental authority in the country of residence or the UNHCR may be entered into tournaments and championships under the WT flag based on prior approval from WT.
- 2. An athlete recommended by a WT-recognized Member National Association
- 3. Holder of a WT recognized Dan or 5-1 Geup
- 4. Holder of a WT Global Athlete License
- 5. Contestant shall be at least 16 years old in the year of the pertinent tournament
- 6. Athletes must go through International Classification in accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Athlete Classification Rules and be assigned a **K44 Sport Class** and Sport Class Status prior to the tournament. Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) or with a Classification Not Complete (CNC) will not be able to compete.

Only athletes from Member National Associations (MNAs) that have an IPC-recognized National Paralympic Committee (NPC) would be eligible to enter the Qualification Tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games.

7. COACH ELIGIBILITY:

In accordance with the World Para-Taekwondo Administration Regulations of International Para Taekwondo Coaches, all coaches officiating in the Qualification Tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games need to be certified World Para Taekwondo Coach Level I.

Note that the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games requires a World Para Taekwondo Coach Level II.

* Athletes that have earned qualification for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games through the World Para-Taekwondo Ranking for Paralympic Regional Games will not be eligible to enter the

Qualification Tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games. The team quota for entries will also be reduced for MNAs that have qualified athletes through the World Para-Taekwondo for Paralympic Regional Games.

** The quota for each weight category might be increased pending the acceptance of qualification slots through the World Para-Taekwondo Ranking for Paralympic Regional Games from the National Paralympic Committees

9. QUALIFICATION TOURNAMENT SLOTS

The Qualification Tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games will allocate slots as follows:

a. Male athletes (10)

Each of the five (5) Paralympic Men K44 weight categories will qualify the top two (2) athletes.

In order to determine the replacement athletes or third place athlete a match will be held between the athletes eliminated in the semi-finals to determine the 3rd and 4th placed athletes, in the case of additional slots being available in a weight category or in the case a qualification slot gets rejected by a National Paralympic Committee.

For reallocation of slots following the tournament the following order will be used:

5 th place	athlete who was eliminated against the gold medalist in the Quarter finals
6 th place	athlete who was eliminated against the silver medalist in the Quarter finals



11. CLASSIFICATION

Athletes entering the Qualification Tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games must be classified in the K44 Sport Class OR go through athlete classification on March 21, 2023 and be assigned a K44 Sport Class with a Confirmed "C", Review "R" or Fixed Review Date "FRD" with a date after 2023 in order to compete.

a. Sport Class K44

b. International athlete classification

The term "Classification" refers to a structure for Competition to ensure that an Athlete's Impairment is relevant to sport performance and that Athletes compete equitably with each other. The purpose of Classification is to define who is eligible to compete in Para-Taekwondo and to group athletes in sports classes for competition in Kyorugui.

c. Medical Diagnostic Form

The Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) must be completed in English by the athlete's physician or physiotherapist.

The completed form must be submitted by the registration deadline before the athlete undergoes athlete evaluation. This applies to all athletes with a physical impairment competing in WT. Depending on the athlete's health condition and impairment, additional medical information is to be attached to the MDF. Please consult the WT Classification rules for a list of eligible impairments and underlying health conditions for Kyorugi

You must upload the MDF to the WTCS, this will be explained below.

NOTE – Failure to submit MDF and medical information can lead to your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a "Classification Not Complete", "CNC". The athlete will then not be able to compete at the event.

d. World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS)

World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the WT Classification Evaluation Group in order to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

Fill out and submit the MNA Account Request form to the Para-Taekwondo Department at para-tkd@worldtaekwondo.org. The username and password will then be sent to the communicated email address.

NOTE – Failure to submit MDF and medical information can lead to your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a "Classification Not Complete" or "CNC." The athlete will then not be able to compete at the event.

*WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate precisely one (1) primary userresponsible for WTCS Account.

e. Classification Schedule and location

The classification schedule will be sent out following the close of registration. Classification will take place on <u>March 20, 2023.</u>

f. Guidelines for International Athlete Classification

The athlete should be wearing sports clothes (tracksuit). The athlete also needs to bring their uniform (dobok) and all personal protective equipment. The athlete should also bring any relevant medical information to classification.

Teams should have a translator with a good understanding of English.

The athlete should always do their best on the tests and exercises requested by the International Classifiers.

12. COMPETITION RULES

The competitions will be held under the most latest World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules.

*NOTE that Article 10.5 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be in effect. Athletes that fail the weigh-in shall be **disqualified**. All athletes are required to be registered in the correct weight category by the registration deadline. **Weight categories will not be changed in case the athlete does not pass the weigh-in!**

13. METHOD OF COMPETITION

Single elimination tournament under the one round duration of contest with a match to determine the 3rd and 4th placed athletes.

The duration of the contest shall be one round of five (5) minutes with one (1) minute timeout for each athlete. In the case of a tied score after the completion of the five (5) minute round, a round of one (1) minute will be conducted as the Golden round, after a one (1) minute rest period. No timeout can be taken during the Golden Round.

Each coach will be allowed to call for one (1), one (1) minute timeout at any time during the one-round contest.

The duration of the contest may be adjusted to four (4) minutes or three (3) minutes upon the decision of the Technical Delegate for the pertinent Championships.

Win by Point Gap (PTG) 30 points will be implemented throughout the championships.

14. SEEDING

Athletes will be seeded based on their points in the March K44 World Para Taekwondo Ranking for Paralympic Regional Games.

15. WORLD PARA-TAEKWONDO RANKING

The Qualification tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games will hold a World Para Taekwondo **G1** ranking status.

In accordance with Article 6.4 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, "all competitions recognized by WT shall be formed with the participation of no less than three (3) countries. Official results from Para Taekwondo Competitions with less than three (3) countries participating shall not be recognized by WT.

Any Sport Class and weight category with less than three (3) athletes from two (2) countries shall not be recognized in the official results to award World Para Taekwondo Ranking points.

16. PSS

The Qualification Tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games will use **Daedo Gen – 2** Protector and Scoring System (PSS).

17. ATHLETE UNIFORM

Athlete uniforms (Dobok) shall be modified in accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Uniform Specification Guide.

Participating contestants are required to wear WT and PATU-recognized doboks and WT-PATU-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of the WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available on the website of WT (http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtf-partners/recognized).

The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks, shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for the inspection of their doboks and protective equipment. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.

18. COACH ATTIRE

Coaches are required to wear formal suits such as ties, jackets, dress shirts (long or short), and trousers during the event. Suppose any coach refuses to wear the abovementioned attire. In that case, he or she will not be allowed to access the field of play for the Qualification Tournament for Para Pan American Games, Santiago 2023.

19. WEIGH-IN & RANDOM WEIGH-IN

- i. The general weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before the competition.
- ii. Random weigh-in of the contestants shall occur on the morning of the competition day at 9.30 am except for M+80 & W+65. All contestants in the draw must be presented.
- iii. Random weigh-ins will be held on the morning of each competition day from 9.30 am. A set percentage (% to be announced at the head of team meeting) of athletes from each weight category will be **randomly drawn and announced at 07:00**.
- iv. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants, and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants 18 years and older may weigh in nude if they wish to do so.

20. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

- i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day before the start of the competition on March 21st, 2023, at 16:00 hrs. in the presence of the PATU and PANAM SPORTS officials, the representatives of the participating nations. Each participating team may send two (2) representatives to attend the Head of Team meeting.
- ii. During the meeting, important information regarding the competitions, procedures, and competition rules will be shared with the teams
- iii. All teams should send representatives to the Head of the Team meeting.
- iv. In case of no representative can be at the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform the Technical Delegate or PATU President's Office before the meeting.

21. DRAWING OF LOTS AND PUBLICATION

The drawing of lots will be made following the completion of athlete classification and weigh-in. All athletes with World Para Taekwondo Ranking for Paralympic Regional Games points will be seeded in accordance with the World Para-Taekwondo Ranking Bylaw based on the March 2023 World Para Taekwondo Ranking for Paralympic Regional Games, including all results until February 28, 2023, except points earned from the Lima 2019 Para Pan American Games.

22. LIVESTREAM

The Qualification tournament for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games will be livestreamed. The streaming channel will be announced shortly.

24. WT GLOBAL LICENSE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION.

- i. WT Global License Registration. All athletes and team officials must first be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) OR Global Official License (GOL).
- ii. WT Online Registration. (Simply Compete)

National team entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system, and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS admins will be notified via email once online registration is open. All Athletes and officials must be registered under the team name Country Name National Team.

Once an MNA registers online through GMS, registration cannot be changed after March 10th, 11:59 pm Rio de Janeiro Local Time.

** After March 15th, it is only allowed to withdraw in case of injury. The MNA must submit the medical documents of the injured athlete within four (4) days of the notification of withdrawal. (ref. WT Medical Withdrawal Policy http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/medical-anti-doping/medical/forms/)

25. ENTRY FEES:

- i. The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee in cash in US\$ only at the CBTKD Registration Center in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, prior to the start of the competition. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of the entry fee to the Organizing Committee.
 - ii. The credential collection will be held at Venit Hotel from March 18-20, 2023.

26. ENTRY DEADLINES & IMPORTANT DATES

Entry deadline for **regular registry** period is March 8th, 11:59 pm Brazil Local Time. Entry deadline for **late registration** period is March 18th, 11:59 pm Brazil Local Time.

Entry submission after this date will be not accepted under any circumstances.

In case of replacement of an injured athlete, PATU may authorize to replace this athlete no later than March 18th. The pre-registered athletes or team officials may be replaced without any penalty before March 10th, 11:59 pm Brazil Local Time.

Entry fee of US\$250 per athlete will be charged in case of cancellation of participation after March 18th, 11:59 pm Brazil Local Time.

*To register, an athlete is required to be in the proper physical condition to compete at the Para Pan American Games Qualification Tournament. Any athlete who withdraws after the weigh-in will be subject to an investigation as to whether or not the withdrawal was in bad faith. (Bad faith includes, but is not limited to, having a prior illness or injury such that it was unreasonable to expect the athlete to be able to compete at the time of the weigh-in.) The burden will be on the athlete to demonstrate that the withdrawal was not in bad faith. If the investigation panel determines that the withdrawal was in bad faith, the athlete will be suspended for up to 6 months,

and the athlete and members of the athlete's entourage may be subject to an additional Ethics investigation.

- Athletes: MNAs have to submit entries online by logging into the WT GMS. MNAs can send a maximum of 2 athletes per weight category. No additional athletes are accepted. No reserve athlete is accepted. No entry will be accepted or modified at BRAZIL's accreditation center(s).
- Team officials: MNAs must register online by logging in to the WT GMS for a maximum of one (1) head of team per country, two (2) coaches per team for Kyorugui, and two (4) team medical staff per team.
- Penalty: A penalty of US\$100 per person shall be paid to the Organizing Committee at the accreditation center in BRAZIL in the following cases:
- 1. Any team official who is not registered online and wants to be accredited at the accreditation center in BRAZIL only if the total number of team officials does not exceed the designated number.
- 2. In case of exceeding the designated number of MNA officials and wants to be accredited at the accreditation center in BRAZIL or any MNA official who is not registered online and wants to be accredited at the accreditation center in BRAZIL,
- 3. Any changes or additions to team official after March 18th, 00:00 Brazil Local Time. This penalty will be considered the onsite fee for approved additions or changes to the national team list.

27. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

i. Round-trip Airfare and Accommodation.

Round trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating Member National Association. Accommodation in the official hotels is mandatory to receive transportation and full onsite information. The OC will not be responsible for any inconvenience outside the official Hotels.

28. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

The PATU will appoint a total of 20 International Referees, including the PATU Referee Chairman. The appointed international referees shall officiate at the Qualification Tournament; the following conditions shall apply:

a. International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.

- b. The Organizing Committee shall cover the expenses for three (4) nights' stay of room and board. Check-in: March 20th, 2023 / check-out: March 24th, 2023.
- c. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$150 to the selected International Referees for the competition and training period (total of three days; US\$450 per referee, training day, and competition).

29. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT/PATU will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and up to five (5) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

The WT will appoint three (3) classifiers as the Classification Panel (up to 25 athletes, if the number is exceeded WT will appoint a second Classification Panel). Each will receive the stipend accordingly to WT Para Taekwondo Event Operation Rules.

The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$200 to the Technical Delegate for 1 day and the CSB members US\$100 for the competition period (total of two days; US\$100 per person).

30. IDENTIFICATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER

I. NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and it shall be **printed at the back in black** and centered at 5cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana". Manufacturer's identifications (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one for the top of Kyorugui dobok within 30cm2 and between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the left arm, one for bottoms of Kyorugui dobok within 30cm2 located above the knee and center of the right leg, and one for Kyorugui belt within 6cm2 at the end of the belt. For Poomsae doboks the NOC code will be allocated on the back.

31. INDEMNITIES

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the competition.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire Public Liability event insurance.

32. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

The participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation only via the official hotels through PATU website by no later than March 15th, 2023. No other registration method will be accepted.

Cancellations must be made in writing.

Please note that cancellations received after March 15th, 2023 are strictly non-refundable. Bookings made after this date are subject to availability. The initial minimum payment will be required at the time of booking; a full cancellation policy will be in place once the booking is confirmed.

Ground transportation will be provided for national teams on arrival and departure free of charge, only for teams who book via the official event accommodation website, and provided that the Organizing Committee has been informed of the date, time, and flight number of the national team's arrival and departure at the latest by the designated deadline (March 15th, 2023).

In Rio de Janeiro, daily transportation is also provided between official hotels and venues for athlete training, registration, head-of-team meetings, and competition days.

Daily local transportation is also provided between official hotels and venues for athlete training, registration, head of team meetings, and competition days, only for teams who book via event accommodation's official website.

During the event, there will be transportation to the venue from the official Hotel only for those who book and pay for their accommodation through the Accommodation Official Site.

(Reservations through Booking, Expedia, Trivago, etc. will not be accepted to shuttle Airport- Hotel-Competition Venue).
