6. QUALIFICATIONS:

In accordance with Article 4: Qualification of Contestant of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

Criterion 1: Holder of the nationality of the participating team.

Criterion 2: An athlete must be nominated by an MNA that is recognized by the WT, or a

eligible wildcard holder.

Criterion 3: Holder of Black Belt Taekwondo Dan.

Criterion 4: Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL) 2023

Criterion 5: An athlete must be 15-17 years old. Born between 2006-2008.

7. COMPETITION RULES WT:

The latest published WT Competition Rules and Interpretation shall be applied. Height division will be used.

8. WORLD OR PANAMERICAN RANKING:

9. METHOD OF COMPETITION

Kyorugui

- Single Elimination system, best of 3.
- Each MNA can register ONE athlete per weight division.
- Wildcard winners must obey competition wildcard rules to be eligible.

Poomsae

- Cut-off system
- Each MNA can register ONE athlete per Poomsae event (Each athlete can perform up to two events).
- Eligible wildcard winners in teams and pairs must compete with the same partners as the wildcard competition.

10. CONTEST TIME

Kyorugui

Best of 3 system (2 minutes x 2 or 3 rounds x 1 minute break)

Poomsae

Recognized Poomsae: Individual, Pair and Team up to 90 second

Free Style Poomsae: Individual, Pair and Mixed Team competitions is from 90 to 100 seconds.

Break between 1st and 2nd Poomsae is a minimum of 30 seconds.

12. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

i. Round-trip Airfare and Accommodation.

Round trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating Member National Association. Accommodation in the official hotels is mandatory there will be no transportation service as the venue is walking distance. The OC will not be responsible for any inconvenience outside the official Hotels.

13. WT GLOBAL LICENSE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION.

- i. WT Global License Registration. All athletes and team officials must first be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) OR Global Official License (GOL) (Level I).
- ii. WT Online Registration. (Simply Compete)

National team entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system, and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS admins will be notified via email once online registration is open. All Athletes and officials must be registered under the team's name Country Name National Team.

iii Wildcard holders will be registered by PATU after MNA GAL approval, for changes in weight division, please email events@panamericantaekwondounion.org

Once an MNA registers online through GMS, registration cannot be changed after April 13th, 11:59 pm Santo Domingo Local Time.

14. ENTRY FEES:

i. The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee **in cash in US\$ only** at the Registration Center in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, prior to the start of the competition. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of the entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

15. ELIGIBLE WILDCARD HOLDERS

Will be considered eligible the medalists of **President's Cup 2022**, Jacksonville, USA. (Accordingly, to the wild card rules for this competition. Max 1 WC per MNA per division).

Winners of all events for:

Pan Am Series II, Costa Rica 2022 Pan Am Series I, Costa Rica 2023 Pan Am Series III, Brazil 2022 Pan Am Series II, Brazil 2023

*Please note, wildcards for Pan Am Series CAN NOT be dragged if an athlete ages up.

PATU WILL REGISTER the wildcard holders after MNA confirmation. An early Registration fee will be considered applied.

17. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

The PATU will appoint a total of 22 International Referees, including the PATU Referee Chairman. The appointed international referees shall officiate at the Pan American Junior Championships; the following conditions shall apply:

- a. International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
- b. The Organizing Committee shall cover the expenses for three (4) nights' stay of room and board. Check-in: April 23th, 2023 / check-out: April 27th, 2023.
- c. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$150 to the selected International Referees for the competition and training period (total of three days; US\$450 per referee, training day, and competition).

18. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT/PATU will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and up to five (5) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

The Organizing Committee shall provide accommodation and board and pay a per diem of US\$200 to the Technical Delegate for 4 days and the CSB members US\$150 for the competition period (total of three days; US\$450 per person).

19. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO UNIFORM (DOBOK) AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

A. DAEDO Gen2 Protector and Scoring System (PSS), including PSS Headgear, will be used for the competition.

- B. Participating contestants are required to wear WT, and PATU-recognized doboks and WT-PATU-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of the WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available on the website of WT (http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtf-partners/recognized).
- C. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks, shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for the inspection of their doboks and protective equipment. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.

Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.

20. IDENTIFICATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER

The national flag shall be located between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the right arm.

I. NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and it shall be **printed at the back in black** and centered at 5cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana". Manufacturer's identifications (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one for the top of Kyorugui dobok within 30cm2 and between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the left arm, one for bottoms of Kyorugui dobok within 30cm2 located above the knee and center of the right leg, and one for Kyorugui belt within 6cm2 at the end of the belt. For Poomsae doboks the NOC code will be allocated on the back.

21. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the competition on **April 23**rd, **2023 at 16:00 hrs** more details to be released soon.

22. WEIGH-IN

- i. General Weigh-in of the contestants shall be completed one day before their scheduled competition day on **April 24**th, **2023**.
- ii. Random weigh-in of the contestants shall take place in the morning on the competition day of their respective weight category except M+78 & W+68. All contestants in draw must be present.
- iii. Junior contestants must be weighed with underwear(s) and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.
- iv. According to WT competition Rules, the number of contestants who will be participated Random weight-in shall be decided per each weight category with 5% allowance as below table.
- v. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. NO weigh-in in NUDITY IS ALLOW FOR UNDERAGED ATHLETES by no means.

23. INDEMNITIES

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the competition.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire Public Liability event insurance.
- iv. All participants must sign the responsibility waiver at the time of registration.

24. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

The participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation only via the official hotels through PATU website by no later than April 20th, 2023. No other registration method will be accepted.

Cancellations must be made in writing.

Please note that cancellations received after April 18th, 2023 are strictly non-refundable. Bookings made after this date are subject to availability. The initial minimum payment will be required at the time of booking; full cancellation policy will be in place once the booking is confirmed.

25. VISA INFORMATION

The visa recommendation letters will be generated from Dominican Taekwondo Federation and PATU The deadline for a visa request is April 5th, 2023. Please send an email to wtdominicana@gmail.com or events@panamericantaekwondounion.org

26. COACH's ATTIRE

Coaches are required to wear formal suits such as ties, jackets, dress shirts (long or short), and trousers during the event. If any coach refuses to wear the abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to access the field of play for the 2023 Pan American Junior Championships.

27. TEAM DOCTOR'S MEETING:

In order to receive an accreditation card, all registered team medical staff must attend the team doctor's meeting on **April 23**rd, **2023**.
