FOR USA ONLY:

U.S.A. athletes and coaches must hold current USA Taekwondo membership prior to Global License approval. USA Participants must allow up to 14 business days for your Global Licenses to be approved and processed. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

This is a World Taekwondo **G2 Kyorugi** & **G2 Poomsae** ranked tournament.

COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY AND FEES (in USD):

All participants must satisfy the following requirements in order to participate. This is an "Open" event, open to all ages and belt levels. Ages 12 years & over Black Belts must have current Global Athletes License (GAL) to register.

- All athletes must hold passport or birth certificate of the country they will represent.
- Competitors will compete at the age based on their birth year. Early Registration Fee (ends February 28, 2022):
- \$150.00 for first event. Extra \$ 75 for each additional event. Regular Registration Fee (ends March 15, 2022):
- \$175.00 for first event. Extra \$ 100 for each additional event. Late Registration Fee (ends March 25, 2022):
- \$200.00 for first event. Extra \$100 for each additional event.

COACH ELIGIBILITY AND FEES (in USD):

- All Coaches must be at least 18 years of age, current Global Official License (GOL) **and** World Taekwondo Coach Permit holders.
- Coaches who fail to provide proof of current WT Coach Certificate will not be allowed to coach at this event.
- Poomsae or Kyorugi: Early registration fee \$150; Regular \$175. Late Registration Fee \$200. Poomsae AND Kyorugi Coaches pay \$150 before March 25, 2020; Late Registration Fee \$300.

MNA DELEGATE, TEAM DOCTOR, TRAINER ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be current holders of World Taekwondo Global Officials License (GOL) in 2020.
- \$100 registration fee for the entire duration of the event before March 15, 2022. Late Fee \$150 from March 15-25, 2022.

MEDIA ELIGIBILITY AND FEE (in USD):

- Eligible to photographers and videographers who represent both public and private sectors. Field of Play access permitted.
- \$200.00 USD, ALL DAYS, available at the Accreditation Desk. Online registration is not available for Media Passes.

TRANSPORTATION:

CHANGES & FEES (in USD):

All change requests made *after March 25, 2022*, including name change, event change, etc. will result in a \$50 administration fee per change request. Weight changes after March 25, 2022 will be subjected to a \$100 Weight Change Fee with no exceptions.

- Changes before March 25, 2022: WT Simply Compete Login
- Changes <u>after March 25</u>, 2022 must be submitted with Change Request Form (see Page 12) and \$100 Change Fee onsite between April 1-3, 2022.

If you make a weight category change within the same registration period that you registered and paid it will be **FREE**. If you make a weight category change in a different registration period from when you initially registered and paid you will be charged the difference e.g. Registered and paid during early bird (until 15 Feb 2022) you can change any time during this period for FREE. If you then change weight category during regular (Feb 16 – March 15) you would be charged the difference between regular and early registration fee. If you change weight category during late registration period (March 16-25) you will be charged the difference between late and early registration fee.

DRAW OF LOTS:

All athletes will be seeded according to WT World Ranking as of March 20, 2022. A minimum of 25% seeding for all divisions according to the WT ranking bylaw. The draw sheets and brackets will be available one (1) day before the start of the competition of the respective weight category.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS:

Current WT Kyorugi and Poomsae Competition Rules will govern the 2022 Puerto Rico Open.

ENTRY FEES, TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

- -All Registration for Athletes, Coaches, and Officials must be completed through the World Taekwondo Event Registration System: https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com.
- All athletes, coaches and officials must have an **approved** 2022 Global License (GAL or GOL) **before** registering.
- Round trip airfares, ground transportation, and room and board expenses shall be borne by all participants.

- World Taekwondo and the Panamerican Taekwondo Union have a NO REFUND policy.
- <u>NO REFUNDS</u> will be given for *any* reason after registration has been completed.

ANTI DOPING REGULATIONS:

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary, the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for all finalists, while random tests will be conducted among the quarter and semifinalists who failed to advance to the (semi-) final. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the PR Open. All contestants are required to submit their latest and most accurate Athlete Location (whereabouts Info) Forms to the WT.

TUE (Therapeutic Use who take any substance or medicine listed): In the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to visit the website of WADA and make online filing of their TUE applications on ADAMS http://www.wada-.org/en/ADAMS/ and report to the WT Sport Department at wtf.dopingfree@gaisf.org no later than 24 March 2022. INDEMNITIES:

Participants without proper participation entry forms and valid medical insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the PR Open. **Liability waivers must be signed** by participants (or by parent or legal guardian for athletes ages 18 and under) prior to the release of credentials at check-in. Photo ID is required to pick up credentials during check-in and weigh-in.

Kyorugi Rules and Competition Format

Organizing committee has the right to change, modify the duration of rounds, divisions and make official decisions without prior notices.

HEAD OF THE TEAM / TECHNICAL MEETING:

PATU technical officials and WT Technical Delegate shall conduct the Head of Team meeting on Thursday March 31, 2022. Head of the team meeting location will be announced one week prior to event date.

The WT Technical Delegate and Organizing Committee have the rights to change, modify the duration of rounds, and combine divisions at the Head of Team meeting. The official draw will be done automatically and posted on the PATU official website.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

All Sparring athletes must wear WT approved black V-neck white uniform (dobok) in good condition. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, athlete names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms.

NO TAPING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM.

COACHES ATTIRE:

All coaches must oblige to wearing business suits (tie optional) for the semifinals and final rounds. Coaches that do not follow the dress code will not be allowed to enter the field of play during finals and semifinals.

SPARRING EQUIPMENT:

Organizer will be using DAEDO Generation 2 PSS & E head system for G2 sparring divisions ONLY. Daedo Generation 2 PSS system will be used for non G2 divisions. All Black Belt competitors are **REQUIRED** to purchase and use their own Daedo sensor socks & heels for the sparring event(s). Daedo sensor socks & heels can be purchased by visiting the Daedo sales booth at the event.

All Sparring competitors are responsible for supplying their own gloves, arm, shin guards, groin guards and mouth guards. No eyeglasses or goggles, prescription or nonprescription, are allowed with no exceptions.

RECOGNIZED BRANDS:

All contestants are required to wear WT recognized doboks and protective equipment. The latest version of WT recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of World Taekwondo http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtf-partnersrecognized/

WEIGH-IN:

The weigh-in of the athletes ages 12 and over will take place at designated weigh-in area **one** (1) day prior to the start of the respective weight category of competition. PLEASE REFER TO EVENT SCHEDULE FOR WEIGH IN TIME / DATE.

- All weigh-in athletes must present a form of government issued photo ID.
- At weigh-in, male athletes (except adults) must wear a minimal of underpants and female athletes (except adults) must wear a minimal of underpants & brassieres. **Under NO circumstances** may a youth, cadet nor junior athlete weigh-in in the nude in Puerto Rico.100 gram allowance will be made.
- Each athlete shall have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh in. However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This extra attempt shall be done within the time limit of the official weigh-in hours on the same day.
- If an athlete wants to change weight at the time of registration, he/she may do so for a fee of \$100.00. A test scale will be available outside of the weigh in rooms.

RANDOM WEIGH IN: All Kyorugi competitors are subject to this new WT rules. Random weigh-in must be completed 1 hour prior to the beginning of each competition day.

WEIGHT CHANGE PROCESS & FEES:

A mandatory Administration Fee of \$100.00 (USD) will be assessed to ALL weight change requests that are made after March 25, 2022 with no exceptions.

Weight changes prior to March 25, 2022 must be made through WT Simply Compete with participant's Login information. Changes **after** March 25, 2022 must be done onsite with completed Change Request Form (see Page 12). An administration fee of **\$100.00 (USD)** will be assessed to ALL weight change requests that are made **after** March 25, 2022 with no exceptions.

Sparring Competitors **CANNOT** participate in more than one (1) weight category in the same age division.

Organizing committee has the right to change, modify and make official decisions without prior notices.

HEAD OF THE TEAM / TECHNICAL MEETING:

OC shall conduct the Head of Team meeting on Thursday, March 31, 2022 from 7pm-9pm.

Designated Poomsae will be drawn at the Head of Team Meeting Thursday, March 31, 2022 at 7 pm. Designated Poomsae will be posted on the PATU official website after Midnight of March 31, 2022.

The WT Technical Delegate and Organizing Committee have the rights to change, modify competition format and combine divisions at the Head of Team meeting.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

WT approved y-neck Poomsae uniforms are mandatory for all competitors in all Poomsae divisions. Cadets and Juniors are allowed to wear Poom or Black Belt with Poomsae uniforms. Poomsae Competitors Age 14 and under must wear Poom Collar Y-neck uniforms.

COACHES ATTIRE:

All coaches must wear business suits (tie optional) for the semifinals and final rounds. Coaches that do not follow the dress code will not be allowed to enter the field of play during finals and semifinals.

FREESTYLE POOMSAE:

Competition shall start from the Final Round, and the top four individual competitors/pairs/team shall be awarded 1st, 2nd and two (2) 3rd place based on their total points in the final round. In the case of a tie, competitor with the higher Technical points win. 3rd and 4th places are awarded with bronze medals.

*Competitor(s) are allowed to use the same music and routine in the same division.

COMPETITION RULES & RANKING:

The Latest WT Poomsae Competition Rules and Poomsae Ranking bylaws will govern the 2022 Puerto Rico Open.

POOMSAE:

Cut-Off system AND Single Elimination:

Single Elimination will be used all Individual Recognized Poomsae divisions (U30 and U40). Cut-Off system will apply to all remaining Poomsae competitions.

CUT OFF SYSTEM:

Preliminaries: When 20 or more competitors are participating; competition shall start from the Preliminary round with division of groups at different rings. Competitors shall perform one (1) designated compulsory Poomsae, and half of each group shall advance to Semi-Final based on the highest scores. In the Preliminary round, each group may be judged by a different group of judges. If the number of competitors is odd, the number of competitors will be rounded to an even number. Ex) If there are 23 competitors in the division, it will be considered as 24 competitors and 12 shall advance to Semi-Final.

Semi-Final Selection: When 9 to 19 competitors are participating; competition shall start from the Semi-Final round. Competitors shall perform one (1) designated compulsory Poomsae, and 8 of them shall be advanced to Final Round based on the highest scores.

Final: When 8 or fewer competitors are participating, competition shall start from the Final Round. Competitors shall perform two (2) designated compulsory Poomsae, and the top four individual competitors/pairs/team shall be awarded prizes based on their total points in the final round. In the case of a tie, competitor with the higher presentation points wins. 3rd and 4th places are awarded with bronze medals.
